What? Who? Anyone living in Wyoming age 7-13 may apply.

When? Application deadline is extended to April 7, 2020. If you are accepted, you will need to attend an informational meeting in mid-April with your parent/guardian, and then work with museum educators and radio reporters on a case-by-case basis to refine your topic and interview techniques. Skype calls or video conferencing are possible.
