

Job Description: Exhibition Production Manager

Summary: The Exhibition Production Manager is responsible for leading the planning, managing, and monitoring of the Center's permanent, temporary, and traveling exhibits. The position collaborates with Center staff, outside contractors, and partners, to oversee and carry out the logistics of exhibition production. This includes creative idea development, design, fabrication, installation, and maintenance of exhibition and collections-related projects, as well as the management of related budgets, timelines, and resources.

Job Duties:

- Develop and implement exhibition designs and layout, coordinate exhibition installation and deinstallation, object rotations, and upgrades to gallery components in conjunction with Curatorial, Education, and Museum Services (CEM) staff.
- Serve as a key team member and consultant for Center staff on all exhibition and collectionsbased projects, including vault storage.
- Maintain calendar of Center's exhibition installations, deinstallations, and object rotations.
- Conduct regular monitoring of exhibition areas and components in communication with curatorial and library staff.
- Serve on committees related to Center exhibitions and special projects and lead regular meetings of the Exhibitions Working Group.
- Design, produce, and install exhibition mounts with consideration of object condition and exhibition aesthetics.
- Maintain digital files, images, and records of each exhibition area and project.
- Maintain list(s) of exhibition resources available for use, including frames and framing materials, pedestals and Plexiglas holdings, and reusable mounts.
- Pack and crate objects for outgoing loans and exhibitions as a Museum Services team member.
- Create and manage an annual budget and yearly and long-range plan for the Exhibitions department.
- Develop and ensure adherence to safe workplace practices and procedures in the operations of the department and the handling of museum collection objects.
- Work collaboratively with all colleagues in the Museum Services division.
- In collaboration with Graphics department, coordinate the production and installation of exhibition texts, prints, vinyl, and labels.
- Coordinate and lead movement of large collections objects in collaboration with Conservator and outside contractors if needed.
- Coordinate installation and maintenance of museum lighting systems with the Facilities department to enhance exhibits and create the desired ambiance in alignment with curatorial and conservation standards.
- Working in conjunction with the Conservator, monitor the condition of artworks and ensure proper environmental controls (humidity, temperature, lighting).
- Working with the AV/IT department, assist with multimedia/ interactive installations.
- Coordinate Preparation functions, including contract labor when needed.

Competencies:

- Proven ability to produce exhibitions with creative and functional elements for positive visitor experiences.
- Project planning aptitude for large- and small-scale exhibitions.
- Ability to use CAD or similar software for exhibition layouts.
- Competency in project planning software such as Smartsheet, Excel, Microsoft.
- Competent in Microsoft Office, Teams, and Outlook.
- Ability to use collection management databases (Argus preferred).
- Demonstrated skills in aesthetically excellent and structurally sound mount making in multiple mediums.
- Demonstrated skills in object installation and handling of two- and three-dimensional objects.
- Basic skills in framing and matting.
- Outstanding interpersonal and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to plan, prioritize, multi-task, and meet deadlines.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with museum staff, professional colleagues, consultants, preparators/art handlers, artists, and contractors.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

• Supervises Exhibition Production Assistant, contract labor, interns

Required Education and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree or higher from accredited college or university in Exhibition Design, Museum Studies with a focus on exhibition design, or design.
- Project management experience on exhibitions and/or construction projects.
- Two years' experience in art and object handling and museum installations.
- Two years' experience with carpentry and metal work, knowledge of materials, processes, equipment, and safety.
- Specific training and/or experience with design and construction of mounts for museum objects using braising, soldering, and other methods and mediums.
